


About The Program

The City of Wadena is currently looking for local organization to participate in its Adopt-A-Park Program. Neighborhoods, student groups, families, businesses and/or other organized groups are encouraged to participate.

Groups will be asked to pick up litter regularly, water flowers, trees and assist with improvement projects.

Specific dates and times are up to the individual organizations. However, we do ask participants to coordinate with Public Works Staff to arrange times and dates ahead of time. A simple phone call to our Public Works crew will help to coordinate the delivery of supplies and pick up of debris.

Suggested frequency of pick-up: Once a month in April and May; twice in June, July and August; and once in September and October.

Additional Information

- *A simple agreement will be signed by the group supervisor on behalf of the group.*
- *The group supervisor will be required to call the Public Works Department to inform them of a planned litter pick-up outing.*
- *The group supervisor will coordinate with the Public Works Department any improvement projects.*
- *All participants under 18 years of age must have responsible adult supervision and submit a parental release form.*
- *Supervisors should have along a first aid kit and be aware of local emergency services in case of injury.*

- **John Ehlen Playground** - 716 3rd St. SE - 1 acre
- **BN Park** - 100 Aldrich Ave. SW - 2 acres
- **Fink's Park** - 304 7th St. SW - .5 acres
- **Sunnybrook Park Campground** - 210 Harry-Rich Dr - 78 acres
- **Sunnybrook Park** - 78 acres
- **Leaf River Trail** - 4.5 mile bike trail
- **SW Athletic Field Complex** - 9 acres
- **Swimming pool/wading pool**
- **Softball / Horseshoe Complex** - 20 acres
